Please complete the form with your email address, your child's full name and class. Appointments will be allocated on a first come first served basis and parents are allocated one slot per child. If parents are separated and do not feel they can attend the same appointment, then we are able to offer a telephone call at another time to the parent not attending. Please email to request this.

Reception time slots are slightly different, if you are unable to make an appointment with Miss Pulfrey, please contact the school office and we can book an appointment with Mr Dodsworth.

If you wish to change your booking, please email the school office. Please do not use the 'edit your response' option as this does not release your previous time for another parent to book.

Once the form is submitted, you will receive an email confirmation with your time slot. If you have any difficulties, please contact the school office.

These appointments will be an opportunity for your child's class teacher to share the progress your child has made so far this year and their next steps for development. Interviews will be held in Class 1; children are welcome to attend but must be supervised by parents at all times.

If you have any concerns regarding other aspects of your child's development, or the school, please do not hesitate to book a separate appointment with either myself or your child's class teacher.

During the evening, please feel free to look at your child's books in Class 2.

In order to cater for all parents, including parents who do not live with their child, appointments are timed. So please do not be offended if the class teacher offers to suspend your interview (once the allotted time has been reached) until another time when you are both at leisure to discuss any issues further. This avoids future appointments being delayed.

As always, if you have any concerns at any time regarding your child's progress or welfare, please contact us immediately to arrange an appointment to see their class teacher or myself.
