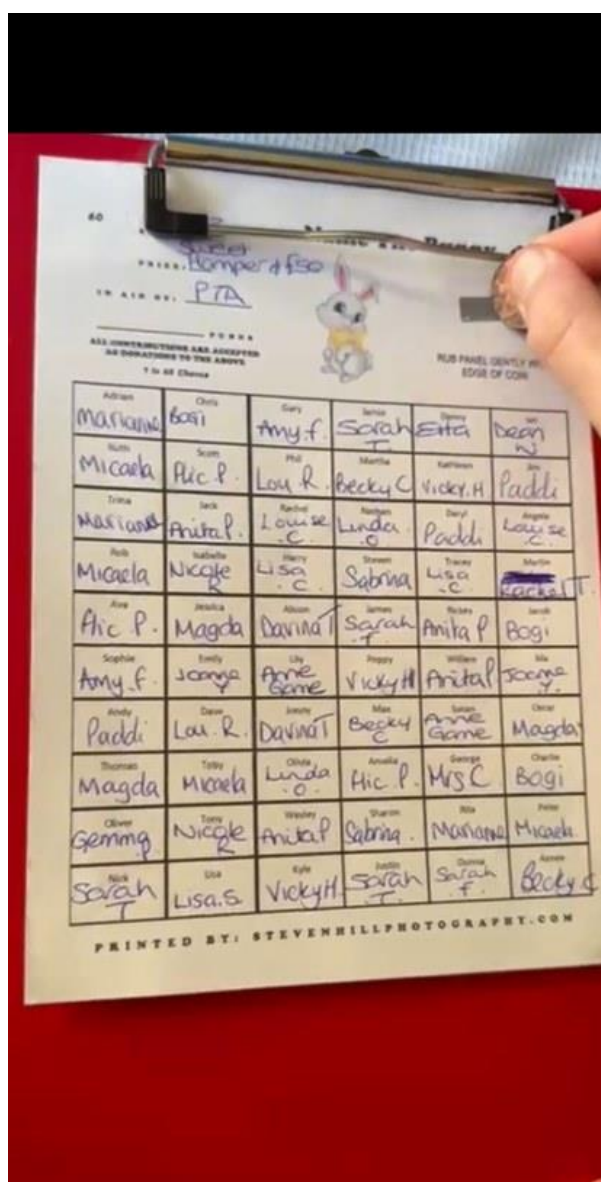
For Parents - How to Talk to Children if they see Traumatic Events

Once you open the link (right click, open hyperlink) in the browser it will ask you to add extension. This means you will not need to remember the easyfundraising address going forward as it will be linked to your computer and will ask if you want to donate to it every purchase.

2. We are also signed up for LotterySK. This is like Postcode Lottery; however, it supports our PTA and local SK communities. For every £1 ticket purchased, Denton C of E PTA get 50p of it and a further 10p goes to other local good causes. Please see the link below:
